10-Year Action Plan


For this plan, what is an "objective"?

A specific, measurable, achievable, relevant and time bound (SMART) act whose implementation will bring the municipality closer to achievement of a goal.

For this plan, what is an "action"?

A specific action that directly supports an objective. Specific and attainable, implementation actions are the steps that can be taken to reach the plan objectives.






While Medford has incorporated arts into the fabric of the city, arts and cultural organizations need ongoing resources.



Although green space is geographically accessible, the impression is marred by poor connectivity and walkability.




